MINI CONFERENCE

This is a one of a kind, in depth, comprehensive mini-conference that was designed for operators, managers and decision makers of public utilities, firemen and ESDA personnel and is specific to Illinois.

For those communities who are in the process of completing a groundwater protection program, this plan meets or exceeds the criteria required by the Emergency Planning step of the program. In addition, Emergency Operating Plans are an integral component of the groundwater protection planning and the technical portion of the SDWA Capacity Development requirement and that certain systems will have to demonstrate to be in compliance. Also, to be eligible for SRF funds most systems will have to demonstrate capacity development.

Upon completion of this two-day training course, the attendee will have been instructed on how to: effectively prepare for an emergency and complete their own emergency

plan with the manual provided. Representatives from IRWA will present sessions addressing the managerial, technical and financial components of Capacity Development .

A representative from ISAWWA will present an evening session on their Emergency Response Planning CD & Workbook.

DAY ONE

IRWA has developed an Emergency Operating Plan that was written by and for Illinois Water and Wastewater Operators.

We will assist public utility personnel in preparing for both natural and man-made disasters. Attendees will receive a copy of "Emergency Operating Plan for Public Utilities" which can be customized for use at your own facility.

In the evening ISAWWA will discuss the Emergency Response Planning CD and several new projects Midwest Technology Assistance Center is funding starting this fall.

There will also be a discussion of the Economic Benchmark Study as well as new Small System Economic Workshops being sponsored by Midwest Technology Assistance Center in 2002.

DAY 2

ABC's of Capacity Development will be the topic of the second days session. This will include the Managerial/Financial and the Technical issues.

IRWA will show you how to achieve Capacity Development in your system and how to document for IEPA.

Also on day 2 there will be some disaster case studies which have affected treatment plants from all over the state and see how their bad situation can be a good lesson for you.

Back by popular demand personnel from the Illinois Emergency Management Agency will bring a disaster scenario to the session and all attendees will be a part of the disaster exercise and how to deal with it. All county Emergency Services & Disaster Agency Coordinators and other emergency personnel must participate in these types of drills to keep accreditation as well as sharpen their skills.
