

## Champaign-Urbana Weather Highlights – April 2001



Several records were set or tied this month:

- The minimum of 64°F on April 6<sup>th</sup> tied the old record high minimum of 64°F set in 1929.
- The minimum of 64°F on April 7<sup>th</sup> broke the old record high minimum of 63°F set in 1929 and the mean temperature of 72°F on April 7<sup>th</sup> broke the old record high mean of 70°F set in 1929.
- The record high of 83°F on April 8<sup>th</sup> broke the old record high of 81°F set in 1890.
- On April 9<sup>th</sup>, record high maximum, high minimum and high mean temperatures were reached. The maximum of 84°F broke the old record of 83°F set in 1905, the minimum of 64°F broke the old record high minimum of 56°F set in 1922 and 1969, and the mean of 74°F shattered the old record high mean of 66°F set in 1922.
- The minimum of 60°F on April 11<sup>th</sup> broke the old record high minimum of 59°F set in 1981.
- The minimum of 62°F on April 21<sup>st</sup> broke the old record high minim of 61°F set in 1977.
- The minimum of 64°F on April 22<sup>nd</sup> broke the old record high minimum of 61°F set in 1985 and the mean temperature of 74°F on April 22<sup>nd</sup> broke the old record high mean of 72°F set in 1980.
- The high of 88°F on April 30<sup>th</sup> tied the old record high set in 1894 and 1895.

There were only eight days this month where the mean daily temperature was below normal. The mean maximum temperature for the month of 69.9°F is the warmest on record and the mean daily temperature for the month (57.9°F) makes this April tied for the 2<sup>nd</sup> warmest April on record. The 1.09" of precipitation ties this April with 1997 for the 9<sup>th</sup> driest on record. For the year, Champaign-Urbana is down 3.66" from normal; however, for the past two months (March and April), Champaign-Urbana is 4.92" below normal.
